SALES TAX TO SUPPORT PUBLIC  
FACILITIES

To pay for public facility purposes, shall Peoria  
County be authorized to impose an increase  
on its share of local sales taxes by one quarter  
of one percent (1/4%) for a period not to  
exceed twenty (20) years? This would mean  
that a consumer would pay an additional  
twenty-five cents (25¢) in sales tax for every  
\$100 of tangible personal property bought at  
retail. If imposed, the additional tax would  
cease being collected at the end of twenty (20)  
years, if not terminated earlier by a vote of the
